Frank A. Karaba Leadership Award & Scholarship

Purpose

To recognize, with an award and a scholarship, a high school senior who has demonstrated service to the church.

Who Is Eligible?

- ~ Be a high school senior and have plans to continue your education.
- ~ Be a member of the First Presbyterian Church of La Grange.

Scholarship Criteria

The primary criterion for the award is service to the church. This includes, but is not limited to, attendance and participation in worship, church school, TUXIS, Isaac Band, Music Program, Vacation Bible School, mission trips, fundraising efforts, mission opportunities, service to the denomination, and other service projects formally connected to the ministry of the local church and the church universal.

Elvan and Louise English Scholarship

Purpose

To support dedicated hardworking Christian youth who are active in the First Presbyterian Church of LaGrange and who are involved in community efforts to help others.

Who Is Eligible?

- ~ Same eligibility as the Metcalf scholarship.

Scholarship Criteria

Same criteria as the Metcalf scholarship, plus involvement in community efforts to help others.

Metcalf, Hellerman & Reid Scholarship

Purpose

To recognize, with a renewable scholarship, participation and faithfulness to First Presbyterian Church of La Grange while here, and to encourage church attendance, Christian activities or summer church involvement while in college.

Who Is Eligible?

- ~ Be a high school senior or a high school graduate who is continuing your education whether at a college, technical institute or other career preparation program.
- ~ Be a member of the First Presbyterian Church of La Grange.

Scholarship Criteria

The primary criteria for the scholarship are participation and faithfulness to First Presbyterian Church of La Grange and to the church universal. This includes, but is not limited to, attendance and participation in worship, church school, TUXIS, Isaac Band, music program, vacation church school, mission trips, fundraising efforts, mission and other projects formally connected to First Presbyterian Church of La Grange or the church universal. Neither academic achievement nor economic need is intended to be the primary criterion for this scholarship.

Key Scholarship Insights

Deadline for Receipt of Applications

Completed applications must be postmarked (if mailed) or received in the church office by **Monday, February 8, 2010**.

Selection Process

An impartial committee composed of elders and pastors will select the recipients of the award and scholarships.

Payment of Scholarship Funds

All scholarships are provided as cash awards in the form of a check issued in the fall. The check is made payable to the recipient's intended school.
